The Northwest School Summer Camp Waiver & Release Form

I the parent/guardian, acknowledge that I am voluntarily requesting that my child participate in The Northwest School Summer Camp's on-campus and off-campus activities and the Student be transported by whatever means the School arranges when activities are scheduled off-campus.

The undersigned hereby gives consent for the Student to participate in each of the activities provided that the undersigned may withdraw consent for the Student's participation in a particular activity by providing written notice to the Director to be received within a reasonable time prior to such activity. The undersigned acknowledge their ongoing obligation to become and remain informed about the School's activities. The undersigned understand that these activities may expose the student to risks of injury.

I understand that all sports and other recreational activities involve a certain amount of risk. I hereby give permission for my child/ward to participate in all Summer Camp activities by The Northwest School and I assume and accept all risk related to such participation. I agree that The Northwest School shall not be liable for any injuries or harm to my student/ward, or to my child/ward's property, or be subject to any claim, demand, injury, or damages whatsoever arising out of my student/ward's participation in any Summer Camp activity. I also understand that The Northwest School cannot eliminate or prevent injuries from occurring to participants.

Further, my student/ward has no medical condition which would prohibit him/her from participation in physical activities, including, but not limited to, the sports activities offered during Summer Camp. I hereby give permission that in the event of any illness or injury, my child/ward may be treated for such illness or injury.

MEDICAL RELEASE: I hereby authorize the Northwest School to have a doctor provide emergency treatment for my child in the event that I cannot be contacted, and I agree to assume financial responsibility for this service. Realizing that there is risk inherent in all and any activities and events, and in consideration of my son's or daughter's being allowed to participate in all and any activities and events, I agree to release, indemnify, and hold harmless The Northwest School, together with its faculty, staff, volunteers, trustees, and other agents, from any and all claims, liabilities, and damages relating to any injury, sickness, death or destruction of any property which may arise out of or result from or be in any way connected with the participation of my son or daughter in all and any activities and events during Summer Camp including transportation to/from related events or activities, other than claims, liabilities or damages based on the gross negligence of The Northwest School or its employees.

In consideration for the Student's being permitted to participate in the Summer Camp activities or in the transportation to those activities, the undersigned hereby release, waive and forever discharge from any liability and hold harmless and indemnify the School, its officers, directors, trustees, employees, instructors, coaches and agents (collectively, the "Indemnified Parties") for any injury to the Student arising out of or resulting from the Student's participation in the activities including the Student's traveling to and returning from any and all activities, but only to the extent that such injury is not caused by the gross negligence or willful misconduct of the Indemnified Party, and for any damages and costs, including attorney's fees and cost of litigation which may be incurred by any Indemnified Party in defense of a claim or claims brought against them by the Student or any other person or entity. This Release of Liability shall be legally binding upon the Student, the Students' parents or guardians, heirs, personal representatives, and assigns. The undersigned have carefully read this Release of Liability and fully understand its contents. The undersigned are aware that we are releasing certain legal rights by this release that the undersigned otherwise may have. Responsible Use Agreement - Information Technology

Information technology use at The Northwest School and by Northwest School community members is rapidly evolving and expanding. This agreement is meant to address the ways in which we use digital communications, social networks, and equipment in a general way. As in all areas of NWS community life, courtesy and common sense should always guide behavior and decisions. In our changing digital world, it is very important to be always mindful of your online reputation and to take every precaution to safeguard it. This agreement is intended to help you develop the habits of good digital citizenship.

General

- I will assume that anything included in an email, text message, or online post is public and permanent.
- I understand that the use of any electronic communications to harass or bully another is unacceptable and will be addressed by the administration. If I am being bullied or harassed, I will report it to a trusted adult so that the behavior can be addressed.
- I will be responsible for the integrity of my account. I understand that sharing my account information or logging in on behalf of someone else is not permitted.
- I will observe the rules of copyright and fair use.
- I understand that the equipment and software owned by The Northwest School is maintained by the Information Technology Department, but it is the responsibility of all community members to ensure that equipment is in good working order. I agree to report problems promptly.

Social Networking

- I understand that teachers are discouraged from interacting with current students on non-school related social networking sites.
- For my own protection, I understand that it is highly recommended that I set my accounts to have the maximum level of privacy. If I am a member of a class social network, I am aware that all members of that social network may see what I post.
- Teachers may choose to use social networks with their classes. I will keep in mind the parallels between inappropriate behavior in the real world and online in virtual spaces: the school may need to act on information that we receive from social networking sites. I will set privacy settings with this in mind.
- I will not post any information that discloses confidential information about the school or personal information about another student or a member of the school community.
- I will not post anything that is disparaging of the school, or of any student or member of the school community (current or former).
- I understand that use of the Northwest School name or logo when creating independent groups or fan pages is not allowed.

Use of Personal Devices

I understand that I may connect my personal devices to The Northwest School network for appropriate educational and personal reasons. I accept responsibility for my behavior online. Use of personal devices should be governed by the same attention to courtesy and common sense that should guide online behavior in general and use of such devices should not interrupt or interfere with your community and academic responsibilities.

I understand that my use of this network is neither private nor confidential and may be reviewed, accessed, and/or monitored by The Northwest School at any time. This right to review, access, and monitor extends to the use of personally owned devices on The Northwest School network. In addition, under some circumstances, such as pursuant to a judicially enforceable subpoena or court order, The Northwest School may have a legal obligation to collect information from the network, including personally-owned devices used on the network, and produce it to a third party. I agree not to use the network to create, modify, send, receive, or save any files, records, images, communications, or other information that you consider to be private or that I wish to keep from broader distribution.

I understand that:

- The Northwest School may selectively limit bandwidth, filter, or block Internet applications and content.
- Use of personal devices should be undertaken with the same ethical behavior that guides the use of school-owned equipment.
- Responsibility to keep personally owned devices secure lies with the individual owner. NWS is not liable for any device stolen, infected, or damaged on campus or at school functions.
- The Northwest School's IT Department will not provide repair services for personally owned technology devices.
- Limited printing from personally owned devices may be supported.

Technology is one of the many tools that The Northwest School uses in its mission to inspire community members to be lifelong learners and stewards of the environment. Responsible and ethical behavior is expected of everyone in all aspects of school life.

Agree to forever release and hold harmless The Northwest School, their respective partners, director, officers, employees and agents from any claims for injury or damage to me, including, without limitation, permanent disability or death, or my property in any way resulting from my use of the Exercise Facilities.
